1. Status

By creating or managing a dig, the Organiser confirms they are independently responsible for the event and have authority to offer attendance.

2. Organiser obligations

- Obtain and maintain genuine landowner/occupier permission and comply with its conditions.
- Provide accurate date, start/finish time, capacity, price, location, access, restrictions and cancellation information.
- Maintain appropriate public liability and any other insurance reasonably required for the event.
- Carry out appropriate risk assessment, site management, emergency planning and attendee supervision.
- Comply with applicable metal detecting, heritage, treasure, land access, health and safety, safeguarding and other laws.
- Manage minors, additional attendees, spade carriers and any other attendees under the Organiser's event rules.
- Use Stripe Connect and comply with Stripe verification and payout requirements.
- Use attendee data only for legitimate event administration and protect private location/identity information.

3. Attendance tools

QR, online and offline registers are administrative aids. Offline actions may synchronise later. The Organiser remains responsible for resolving discrepancies and maintaining an accurate event attendance record.

4. Land forms

Land enquiry, permission and uploaded-document features are tools to help collect, transmit and store information. They do not verify ownership, authority, title, boundaries, consent, legal sufficiency or enforceability. The Organiser must satisfy themselves that permission is valid.

5. Payouts

The Organiser is entitled to the Dig Fee amount recorded for eligible paid attendance, subject to refunds, disputes, reversals, Stripe availability and lawful deductions/adjustments. Instant Payout is not guaranteed; the Stripe Payment & Organiser Payout Terms apply.

6. Prohibited organiser conduct

- Publishing events without authority or valid permission.
- Misrepresenting insurance, capacity, location, price or event conditions.
- Circumventing Platform payments or manipulating booking/attendance records.
- Harassment, discrimination, unsafe event operation or encouragement of unlawful detecting.
- Improper use or disclosure of attendee, landowner or vendor personal data.
